LEVEL ONE RULES

IT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO:

- 1. Leave classrooms and/or offices without permission AND an official pass**
- 2. Use the bathroom during the following times:**
 - the first 10 minutes of class**
 - the last 10 minutes of class**
 - passing time in between periods**
 - Study Hall**
- 3. Wear headgear of any kind**
- 4. Use electronic devices of any kind; cell phones, sidekicks, iphones, ipods, mp3s, mp4s, game boys, PSPs, or any other text messaging, instant messaging, AIMing, picture/phone communication-entertainment device.**
- 5. Eat or drink in the building except in the cafeteria.**
- 6. Be late to school or class.**
- 7. Cut class**
- 8. Play cards or dice**
- 9. Engage in disruptive activities**

LEVEL TWO RULES

IT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO:

- 1. Use inappropriate language**
- 2. Vandalize school property**
- 3. Leave the building without permission**
- 4. Engage in scholastic dishonesty**
- 5. Engage in sexual behavior or commit sexual harassment**
- 6. Fight or engage in roughhousing**
- 7. Use or carry drugs, alcohol, cigars, or cigarettes**
- 8. Use or carry weapons of any kind**

Violation of Level Two school rules will be promptly and firmly dealt with and may result in one or more of the following:

- 1. Possible removal from class**
- 2. Pre-suspension hearing with student and parents**
- 3. Principal's suspension**
- 4. Superintendent's suspension**
- 5. Arrest by police in the case of a serious offense**
