At UNHS, college preparation starts in 9th grade and continues through graduation. Beginning in the 9th grade, students explore how to choose a college, apply for scholarships and financial aid. and write application essays. 10th, 11th, and 12th graders receive support for PSATs, SATs and ACTs. Our College Summit and College Challenge counselors help students set personal and professional goals. The College Office arranges college tours for students and their parents to Boston College, Princeton, Bridgeport, Albany, Stony Brook, NYU, University of Massachusetts, Harvard, Boston University, Fordham, Manhattan College, Baruch, New Paltz, Columbia University, and University of Connecticut. Deloitte Academy students receive small group mentoring, professional resume writing, college application support, job shadowing, and scholarships.

Our students also have opportunities to earn tuition-free college credits while still in high school. In addition to courses offered on the Baruch campus, we also offer College Now courses at UNHS! Students can receive tuition-free college credits from Baruch College and LaGuardia Community College.
